

## **SB046 – Clubhouse Skateboard, Bicycle and Scooter Policy**

### **Purpose**

The purpose of this policy is to ensure a safe environment for members and guests during club events held in and/or on clubhouse grounds.

### **Scope**

The boundaries of this policy apply to the following areas:

- The concrete apron to the **East** of the clubhouse (extending to the public footpath)
- The café area to the **North** extending to the public road
- The **West** of the clubhouse inclusive of footpath on either side of the public road extending to the grass hill
- The **South** side of the clubhouse extending to the public road (inclusive of the shower area and foot path)

This policy is inclusive of all forms of recreational mobility devices including:

- Skateboards
- Rip Sticks
- Bicycles
- Roller Skates
- Roller Blades
- Scooters

This policy will be enforced during the following club events

- Weekend Entertainment (Bar hours)
- Surf Club Meetings (JAC or Senior/Executive)
- After Carnival meetings (Typically BBQ and Bar)
- Sunday Morning or Twilight Nippers
- Carnivals held at Shelly Beach
- Functions including Christmas, Opening and Closing BBQs

### **Application of Policy**

This policy applies to all members of Shelly Beach Surf Club irrespective of age or membership category and is not negotiable.

Any person found with an above mentioned recreational mobility device within the exclusion area will be asked to remove the device immediately.

Parents and/or guardians will be held accountable for any breach to this policy by minors under their care. Repeat offenders may face expulsion from the club.
