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Shelly Beach Surf Lifesaving Club Education Policy for Covid 19. (SB071)

Policy Effective 29 July 2020 – Version 2

All education activities must follow any **NSW Public Health Orders**, as well as the current **directives from SLSNSW** in regards to education and training.

Refer to the Department of Health's general guidance on protecting others and stopping the spread by practicing good hygiene and physical distancing.

If any Member has been unwell or been in contact with a known case of COVID-19, they are to isolate immediately and remain in isolation for a period of 14 days. Should they be diagnosed with COVID-19, they are to remain in isolation until they are medically cleared of the virus.

A maximum of 10 people (including trainers) can be in the Lupica room at any one time, whilst maintaining social distancing etiquette at all times. Larger groups must relocate to the Stanford room (if available). Refer to the 'Training Room or Area Set-Up' section of the **directives from SLSNSW**.

Trainers must record names and contact details (email or phone number) for all participants of all Surf Life Saving activities and records kept for a minimum of 4 weeks (28 days). These records must be kept secure and only used for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections.

Trainers should support candidates to Download the official 'Coronavirus Australia' App from the **Apple App Store** or **Google Play**, or join the **Whatsapp channel** on ios or Android.
